**SPORTS JOURNALISM SEMINAR AGAIN SCHEDULED TO BE HELD
IN CONJUNCTION WITH CHAMPIONSHIP SATURDAY WEEKEND**

DENVER – The Colorado Sports Hall of Fame will sponsor an evening seminar in sports journalism, writing, photographs and television, for high school students as part of Championship Saturday weekend and the Colorado High School 4A and 5A championship football games. A panel of sports writers, photographers and television reporters will show and tell of their work covering sports in Colorado.

All high school journalists are invited to the program beginning at 7 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 29, in the auditorium of the new Denver Newspaper Agency office building, 101 West Colfax in downtown Denver. The football championships are scheduled for Saturday, Dec. 1, at INVESCO Field at Mile High.

The seminar is organized for the CSHF by Rich Clarkson, longtime Sports Illustrated contract photographer and former director of photography of the National Geographic Society. His Denver firm handles all photography for the Colorado Rockies and all 88 national championships of the NCAA.

In addition to the seminar, a competition among Colorado high school photographers to find the best sports picture of the fall will be held, with the winner announced at the seminar. All high school photographers in Colorado are eligible to enter pictures made during the 2007 school year. The winner will receive a state-of-the-art professional digital Nikon D40 camera, and his or her school will also receive another of the same cameras, both donated by Nikon Inc. as part of its ongoing programs in support of photographic education.

Entries are limited to three pictures from each student and may be either 8 x 10 prints or digital files submitted on a CD or e-mailed to higschoolcontest@ncaaphotos.com. The photographer's name, address and school should accompany the entry, which may also be mailed to the High School Sports Contest, NCAA Photos, 1099 18th Street, Suite 2840, Denver, CO 80202.
